## Stakeholder Input and Consultation

A key element of the Scheme development involves consultation with all interested parties. This consultation offers an opportunity for everyone to give their views on the viable options, thereby influencing the decision-making process. All comments are considered and, where relevant, incorporated into the scheme design.

## Opportunities for you to shape Coirib go Cósta

Defence options for the scheme will be assessed based on feedback received, environmental, technical and economic viability. When this process is complete an emerging Preferred Scheme will be recommended. The emerging Preferred Scheme will be presented to the public at a third Public Engagement Day. Final public feedback on the Preferred Scheme will be incorporated into the final design which will be progressed through the planning consent process.

The statutory consultation will be conducted as required during the planning consent process.
